

1. All Persons on site must undertake a site induction prior to starting.
2. The site working hours will be confirmed by the Supervisor to NYH Operatives and Subcontractors prior to starting on site
3. Unauthorised persons are not allowed on site apart from those who live/work within the site limits. There will be pedestrian access only during an 8hr period unless otherwise agreed.
4. During a restricted access period no vehicles will be allowed on site with the exception of emergency vehicles and authorised visitors/residents, which should be previously agreed with NYC and NY Highway. This will only be permitted if the works allow and should be detailed in the advanced notification letter.
5. High Visibility vest with  $\frac{3}{4}$  length sleeves or jacket.  
High visibility trousers  
Safety Helmet  
Safety footwear (not rigger boots)  
Hand protection (gloves)
6. Eye protection (can be integral part of helmet)
7. Shorts and bare torsos are not permitted on site.
8. All persons must strictly comply with the employer's safe system of work – especially the PPE Standard, and conduct themselves in an orderly manner at all times.
9. All reversing of vehicles must be controlled by a banksman.
10. All site plant and equipment must be designed and fit for the task for which it is being used.
11. All maintenance operations are to be carried out by trained/competent and authorised persons.
12. All plant to be operated by trained/competent and authorised persons only and hold the relevant certifications.
13. All site rules must be brought the attention of all site personnel and visitors to site. This will be given by the Supervisor at the start of the works or by the Site Supervisor in charge of the site should anyone need to enter site after the initial induction has taken place.
14. Eating and drinking must only be undertaken at the nominated welfare facilities.
15. All site employees to undergo a toolbox talk by their employer regarding their method statements and safe systems of work before starting on a new activity.
16. All accidents/incidents, including Near Misses, are to be reported to the Site Supervisor immediately.
17. All site hazards are to be appropriately guarded and signed.
18. All operatives must follow government and company COVID-19 guidelines.
